## Closing Thoughts:

- Christian Education should be positive. It is not just teaching what is wrong with the world's education. . The Christian teacher restores the content of any curriculum to its proper position before God.
- Biblical integration is not primarily an issue about which textbooks to purchase. It is an issue about which teachers to hire. The mature Christian teacher can profess Jesus Christ as Lord of any textbook or literature.
- Teachers largely determine the look and feel of Christian elementary schools, but the students more deeply influence the look and feel of Christian middle and high schools.
- What is the "look and feel" of Providence Academy middle and high schools?
  - Is there evidence that the Spirit is working in the hearts and lives of the students?
  - Do we embrace folly or confront it with timely, loving, and firm discipline?
  - Are the students being taught to obey or just respect the Bible?
  - Do we sometimes seek to protect or rescue students rather than confront their sin and call them to repentance?
- The Bible is authoritative in all matters that it addresses. The Christian school teacher teaches the authority of the Bible by obedience to the claims of Christ. If the Word of God is merely present in the school but not authoritatively applied in all areas of school life, the students will learn that Scripture is meant to be respected but not obeyed.
