



## 2019-2020 FEE SUMMARY

### All Students:

The enrollment fee for each new student is due with registration paperwork upon acceptance in order to hold the seat.

### Important Notes:

- Enrollment fees are required for new students, including newly enrolling siblings.
- Tuition payments are affected by tuition assistance.
- Parents receiving tuition assistance do not qualify for discount for full tuition payment.
- **Tuition payment schedules run June 1 through May 1 over twelve (12) months.**
- **Please see current financial policy for withdrawal policy regarding refunds.**

## **Other Fees:**

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Extended Care is available for each full school day during the 180-day school calendar. Annual fees are set based on school days and not on attendance within individual months. The program is available Monday through Friday, 3:00PM – 5:30PM.

Annual Prepaid:      \$1,150 (10 monthly payments of \$115 beginning August 1)  
Daily Rate:            \$15 per day (billed at each month end)

*Daily rate is applicable for the secondary study hall; elementary students may opt in and out of the program only on a monthly basis.*

Secondary physical education classes require specific apparel (shorts and shirt)

Cost: \$21

All students in grades 7-12 are required to purchase assigned consumable books. The fees for these vary by course. In addition, students are provided with a set of textbooks, which must be returned at the end of the school year. If books are damaged to be unusable or lost, parents will be charged for repair or replacement.
